Eligibility Criteria: Open to NAHEC members only for projects implemented between July 1, 2006 and December 31, 2007.

Guidelines:

- Awards will be presented at *Engage. Challenge. Inspire.2008* in Cincinnati, OH, on Monday, June 23rd during the morning presentation.
- Nominations may be submitted by any NAHEC member individual, center, or organization. Nominations may also be submitted by non-member community organizations and/or individuals.
- Nominations are assessed by an impartial awards committee. Information assessed by the committee will be kept confidential.

How to Apply:

- Complete a nomination form
- Attach a 500 word or less summary of the project to the nomination form
- Collect two letters of recommendation from colleagues
- Complete narrative statements on attached nomination form

Additional support information such as DVDs, CDs, audio tapes, photographs or web pages may be submitted with the nominations package.
